# Quick start: DigitalDecorationPlayer

### 1. Measure your windows

To ensure that we can plan your show properly, we first need a list of all the windows that we want to include in the show. Simply use the form in the appendix. The following information is important here:

# 2. Create show

#### Start tool (overview)

Open "DigitalDecorationPlayer.com" in your browser. If you do not yet have an account, create one under "My Account". Then open the 'DigitalDecoration-Player' tool under 'Tool bench' with '>>Launch tool<<'. Here you will find Dashboard with all important functions.



#### Select scenes

With "Show MediaPool for this Show" you can display the MediaPool for your show. Select all the scenes you want to show in your show and then save everything with "Save Changes".



#### Add windows

With "Add another Player" you can now create all windows one after the other.

#### **Create connections**

Finally, you must specify connections once for each window via "Show more settings" at the bottom via "Add a connection". To do this, imagine that you are standing in front of the house. Then specify the direction of the connection, e.g. to the right. Then select the window that lies in this direction, e.g. "1st floor left bathroom window" and enter the distance.

# 3. Prepare windows

Now install your projection material on the windows.



### 4. Set up the equipment

Now place a projector at each window. We currently recommend a laptop or PC as a playback device. Small MiniPCs (from company stocks) are sometimes even available quite cheaply on e.g. ebay for \$50. With small loudspeakers, you can also transmit the sound outside.

Tip: Many of the small projectors have a mounting thread on the underside, for example. This allows you to attach the projector to a tripod, as shown in the example image, so that the image can be optimally adjusted.





## 5. Start the show

Start all projectors and PCs and open the website "dd-player.com" in full screen. You may be asked to press a button. As soon as you have done this, a 6-digit letter and number code will appear. Open the website "digitaldecorationplayer.com" on your cell phone and start the tool "DigitalDecorationPlayer" ('Overview'). Here you will find a list of your windows. Click on "Connect player" and enter the 6-digit code. Your window should then start the show in the next 30 seconds!



### 6. Remote Control

You can access the remote control via the "Remote Control" button. Here you will find all the settings again, but this time in a dark mode. In this way, you can easily adjust the volume or change the window settings.

Changes that directly affect the flow of the show, such as which videos are running, whether the projector is in front of or behind the window or the connections between the windows, may take up to 15 minutes before you see the effects.
